Healthwatch Wiltshire wins national award for work with young volunteers



We are delighted to have earned national recognition for a project which gave hundreds of young people a chance to speak up about their mental health.

We picked up an award for Volunteering at the Healthwatch England conference in Stratford upon Avon on Wednesday 3 October, an event which brings together Healthwatch teams from across the UK.

In partnership with Youth Action Wiltshire, Community First and local schools, we mentored a group of students, supporting them to learn new skills and build confidence. Some of the students were trained to become Young Listeners, visiting schools and speaking to other students to understand their views on mental health.


The Big Conversation, Devizes Town Hall - 6pm-8.30pm
